## **Technical Guide & Special Regulations**

### Article I. Organization

The Chrono Kristin Armstrong Time Trial is organized by Mike Cooley [mcooley@georgescycles.com](mailto:mcooley@georgescycles.com) 312 South 3<sup>rd</sup> Boise, Idaho USA 83702 under permit of the International Cycling Union. It is also held under USA Cycling Permit #2018-1726 and is on the PRT Calendar. It is to be held on July 13<sup>th</sup>, 2018.

### Article II. Type of Event

The event is registered as a UCI Class 1.2 event and is also registered on the UCI Americas Tour calendar. The UCI regulations and scale of penalties are solely applicable. In conformity with the UCI rules, UCI individual points are awarded according to Class 2 events as follows for Men Elite and Women Elite: 40-30-25-20-15-10-5-3-3-3.

PRT Points for the Chrono Kristin Armstrong are as follows for the first 10 places, Men Elite and Women Elite: 40-30-23-17-13-9-7-5-4-3.

PRT Points for the ASWB Criterium (Saturday) are as follows for the first 10 places, Men Elite and Women Elite: 25-19-14-11-8-5-4-3-2-1.

### Article III. Participation

The event is open to athletes of the UCI Professional Continental teams, UCI Continental teams, National teams, Regional and club teams. Race is limited to a maximum of 50 Men Elite and 50 Women Elite.

### Article IV. Race Headquarters

The **Race Headquarters** shall be open starting at 4:30pm Thursday July 12<sup>th</sup>. The address for **Race Headquarters** is: **Boise Visitor and Convention Center 1101 W. Front Street, Suite 100, Boise, ID**

Team representatives for UCI riders are required to confirm their starters and pick up race numbers at race headquarters from 4:30pm to 6:00pm on July 12<sup>th</sup>.

Riders racing in the amateur Ride Like a Pro race can pick up their race packets from 4:30pm to 6:00pm on July 12<sup>th</sup> at the Race Headquarters. Amateurs may also pick up their race numbers at the start on July 13<sup>th</sup> from 8:00am to 9:00am at Hunter's Creek Sports Park.

A **Mandatory Team Managers** meeting for UCI teams, organized in accordance with the UCI regulations, in the presence of the Members of the Commissaires panel is scheduled for **Thursday, July 12 6:15pm at Race Headquarters, Boise Visitor and Convention Center 1101 W. Front Street, Suite 100, Boise, ID.**

Race Officials will be available at the start location of the race on July 13th 8:00am located at Hunter's Creek Sports Park, 1500 N Star Rd, Star, Idaho 83669.

#### Article V. Starts

The starting order will be established by the organizer based on UCI Individual Rankings as of July 10, 2018. Riders not ranked will be by random draw of the commissaires. The start times will be available at the Team Manager's Meeting. Start times for all category racers will be posted Thursday evening on the [www.ChronoKristinArmstrong.com](http://www.ChronoKristinArmstrong.com) website.

Bicycles must be presented at the start area bike check at least 15 minutes before the rider's start time. Bicycles must conform to UCI regulations for time trial bicycles. The jig will be set up for courtesy bike checks starting at 9:00am on the morning of the race. There will not be a bike check for amateurs racing in the Ride Like A Pro TT.

Starts will be on 2-minute intervals. Timing will begin on the rider's assigned start time. The Chrono Kristin Armstrong is a point-to-point time trial. Please plan vehicles and support accordingly.

#### Article VI. Neutral Tech Support

Technical support service will be provided by George's Cycles Inc. at the start at Hunter's Creek Sport Park.

#### Article VII. Team Support & Vehicles

With the roads open to local traffic traveling in the opposite direction of the race, team cars will not be allowed to pass a slower rider. Riders will be spaced apart by 2-minute intervals in the hope of limiting a takeover. All follow car drivers must carry a current UCI Driver's License. Team vehicles, other than follow cars, can get to the finish by going South on Star Road, turn East on ID-44, and then turn North on HWY 16 to Firebird Raceway.

#### Article VIII. Parking & Warm-Up

Teams are to utilize parking as indicated on the course maps at Hunter's Park, Star, Idaho. The pre-race warm-up area is located on Floating Feather Road west of the Start area. Team Parking at Finish area will be marked appropriately.

#### Article IX. Prizes

A grand total of \$7230 (\$US) in prizes will be awarded equally to Men Elite and Women Elite to the top twenty places: \$2900, \$1440, \$720, \$360, \$290, \$220, \$220, \$144, \$144, Places 10<sup>th</sup> – 20<sup>th</sup>: \$72. A 2% rider's contribution to anti-doping (CADF) will be deducted from these prize amounts. IRS forms must be completed before prizes can be collected. US riders must complete form W-9. Foreign riders must complete IRS Form W-8.

## Article X. Doping Control

The UCI antidoping regulations are entirely applicable to the event. USADA may perform additional testing. The antidoping tests take place at the Finish: Firebird Race Way, 8551 ID-16, Eagle, ID 83616. Doping Control list will be posted at the USADA Tent at the Finish. The location of USADA is marked on the Finish Map.

## Article XI. Medical

Medical will be on site at the finish area at Firebird Raceway.

## Article XII. Awards Ceremony

In accordance with the UCI rules, the following riders must attend the Official awards ceremony:

### **Top Three Men and Top Three Women.**

The riders will present themselves 15 minutes prior to the awards ceremony. Official awards will take place at 6:00pm on July 13th at the J.U.M.P. in downtown Boise at 9th and Front Street.

## Article XIII. Directions to Time Trial

Hunter's Creek Sports Park, Star, Idaho is approximately 16.7 miles from downtown Boise.

From downtown Boise, head West on State Street (turns into HWY 44) to Star, take a Right on Star Road and continue until you get to Hunter's Creek Sports Park, 1500 N Star Rd, Star, ID 83669.

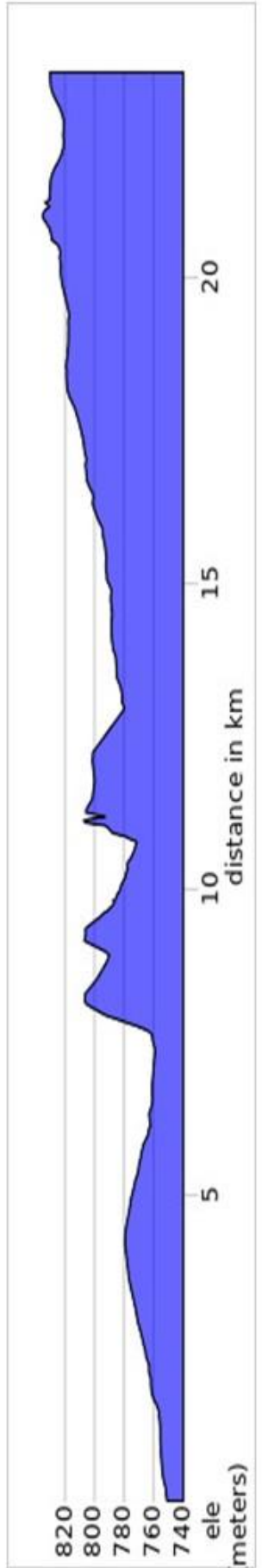
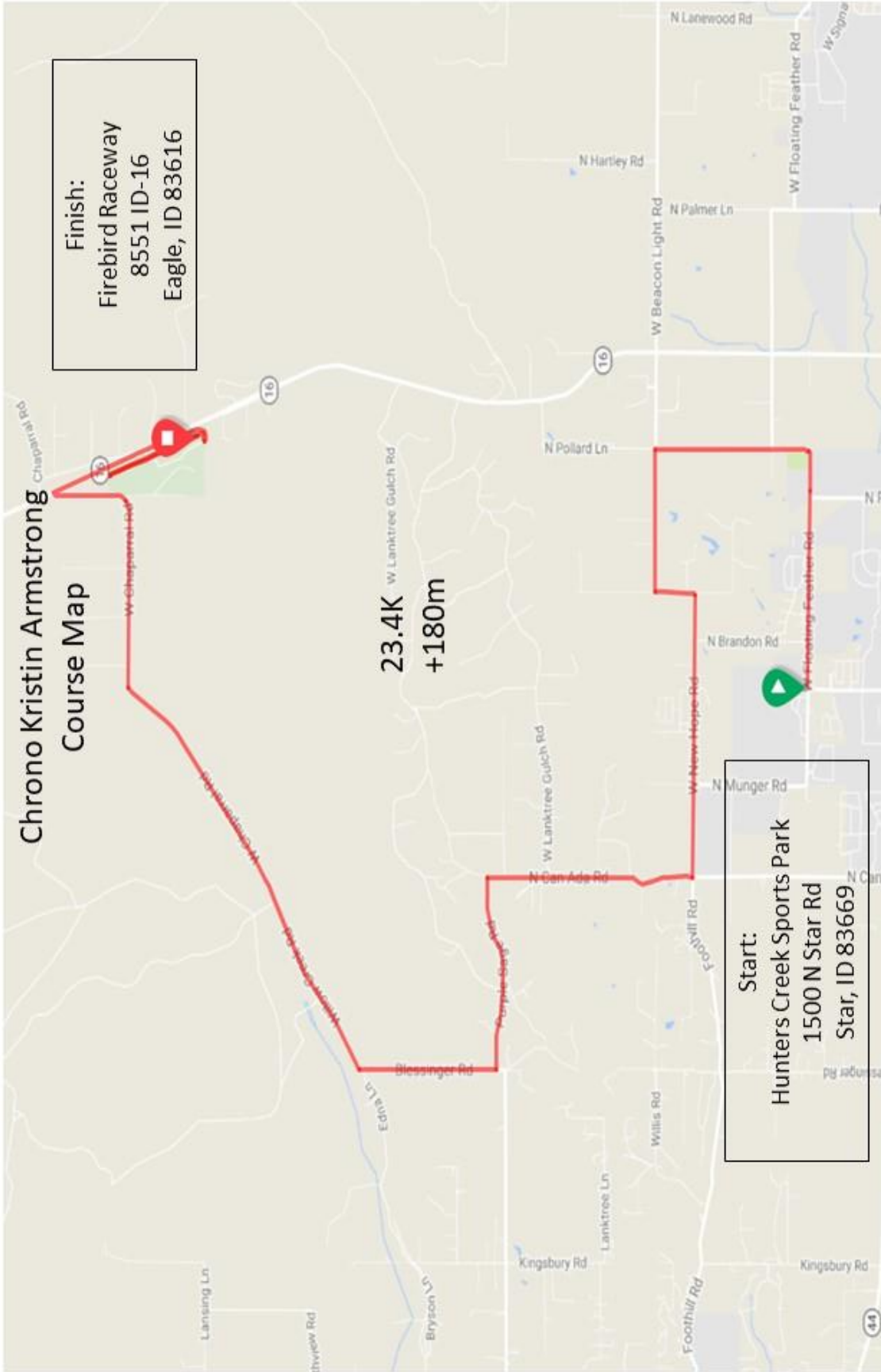

# Course Map and Profile

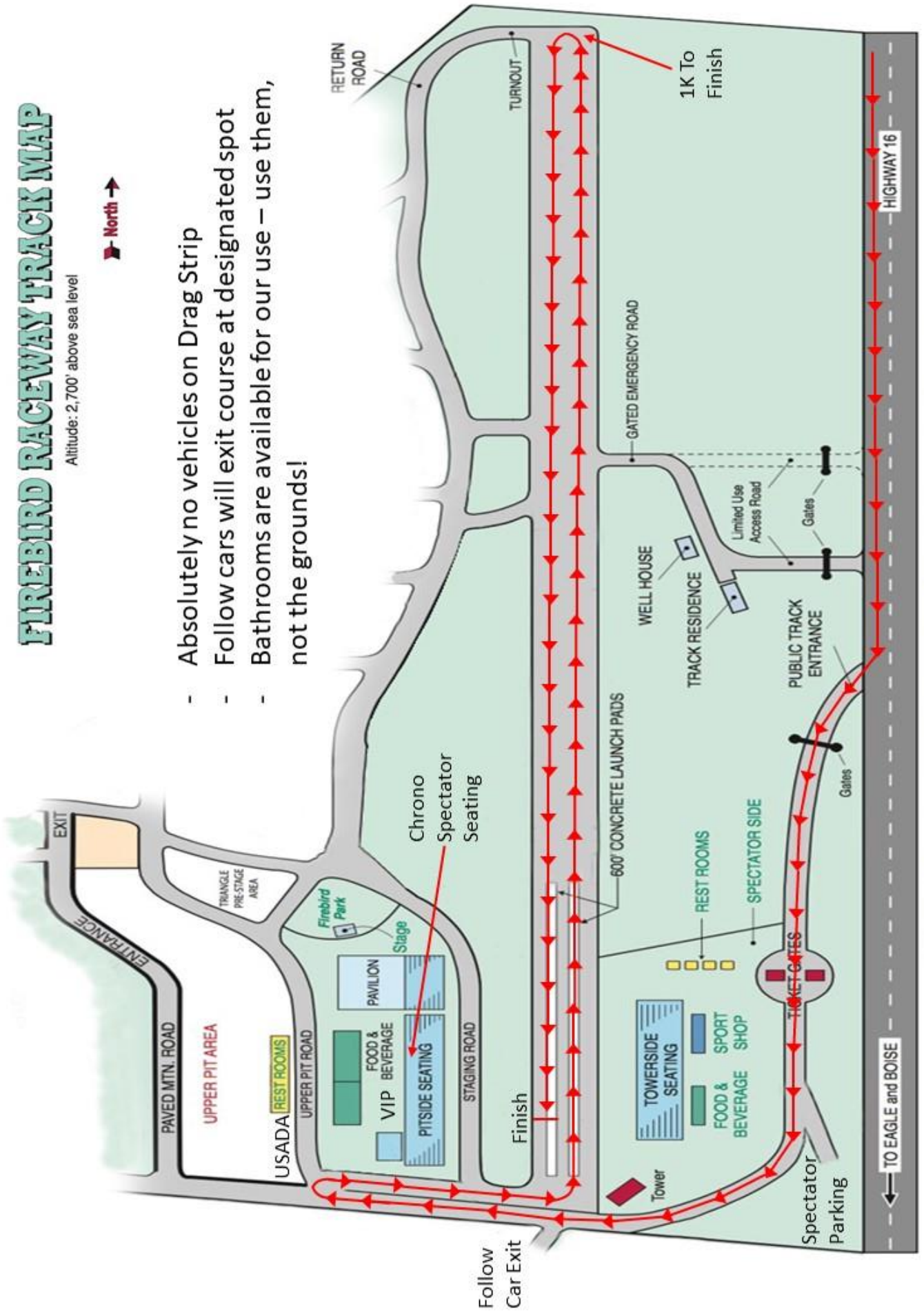


# FIREBIRD RACEWAY TRACK MAP
