Technical Guide & Special Regulations

Article 1. Organization

The Chrono Kristin Armstrong Time Trial is organized under the International Cycling Union (UCI) by

It is also held under USA Cycling Permit #2019-63 and is on the PRT Calendar. It is to held on July 12th, 2019

Article 2. Type of Event

The event is registered as a UCI Class 1.2 event and is also registered on the UCI Americans Tour calendar. The UCI regulations and scale of penalties are solely applicable. In conformity with the UCI rules. UCI individual points are awarded according to Class 2 events as follows for Men Elite and Women Elite: 40-30-25-20-15-10-5-3-3-3 UCI points. PRT Points for the Chrono Kristin Armstrong are as follows for the first 10 places. Men Elite and Women Elite: 40-30-23-17-13-9-7-5-4-3.

PRT Points for the ASWD Criterium(Saturday) are as follows for the first 10 places. Men Elite and Women Elite: 25-19-14-11-8-5-4-3-2-1.

Article 3. Participation

The event is open to athletes of the UCI Professional Continental teams, UCI Continental teams, National teams, Regional and club teams. Race is limited to a maximum of 50 Men Elite and 50 Women Elite.

Article 4. Race Headquarters

The Race Headquarters shall be open at 4:30pm Thursday July 11th. The address for the Race Headquarters is: Boise Visitor and Convention Center 1101 W. Front Street, Suite 100, Boise,ID

Team representatives for UCI riders are required to confirm their starters and pick up race numbers at race headquarters from 4:30pm to 6:00pm on July 11th.

A Mandatory Team Managers meeting for UCI teams, organized in accordance with the UCI regulations, in the presence of the Members of the Commissaires panel is scheduled for Thursday, July 11th 6:15pm at Race Headquarters, Boise Visitor and Convention Center 1101 W. Front Street, Suite 100, Boise, ID.

Race Officials will be available at the start location of the race on July 12th 7:30am. The start is located at Glenns Ferry High School 639 N. Bannock St, Glenns Ferry, ID 83623

Article 5. Starts

The starting order will be established by the organizer based on UCI Individual Rankings as of July 9, 2019. Riders not ranked will be assigned start times by random draw of the commissaires. The start times will be available at the Team Manager's Meeting. Start times for all category racers will be posted Thursday evening on the www.chronokristinarmstron.com website.

Bicycles must be presented at the start area bike check at least 15 minutes before the rider's start time. Bicycles must conform to UCI regulations for time trial bicycles. The jig is available only for starting riders a 15minutes to start, after that courtesy checks at discretion of race commissaires.

Starts will be on 2-minute intervals. Timing will begin on the rider's assigned start time. The Chrono Kristin Armstrong is an out and back time trial.

Start/Finish: Old Oregon Trail road in Glenns Ferry, ID

Article 6. Neutral Tech Support

Technical support service will be provided by George's Cycles Inc. at the start at Glenns Ferry High School and at the turn around on Bennett Mountain Road.

Article 7. Team and Support Vehicles

The race will be an out and back using Old Oregon Trail and Bennett Mt. Road. With bikes traveling in both directions Team cars will not be allowed to pass slower riders.

Article 8. Parking & Warm-up

Teams are to utilize parking as indicated on the course maps at Glenns Ferry High School. The pre-race warm-up area is located on Bannock St. The course will be closed to warm up on race day.

Schedule:

UCI Elite Women: First rider off at 9:30am

UCI Elite Men: First rider off at 12:00pm

Article 9. Prizes

A grand total of \$7230(\$US) in prizes will be awarded equally to Men Elite and Women Elite to the top twenty places: \$2900, \$1440, \$720, \$360, \$290, \$220, \$220, \$144, Places 10th- 20th. \$72. A 2% rider's contribution to antidoping(CADF) will be deducted from these prize amounts. IRS forms must be completed before prizes can be collected. US riders must complete form W-9. Foreign riders must complete IRS Form W-8.

Article 10. Doping Control

The UCI antidoping regulations are entirely applicable to the event. USADA may perform additional testing. The antidoping tests take place at the Finish. Glenns Ferry High School, 639 N. Bannock St. Glenns Ferry, ID 83623. Doping Control list will be posted at the USADA tent at the finish. The location of USDA is marked on the finish map.

Article 11. Medical

Medical will be on site at the finish area at Glenns Ferry High School.

Article 12. Awards Ceremony

In accordance with the UCI rules, the following riders must attend the Official awards ceremony: TOP THREE MEN AND TOP THREE WOMEN.

The riders will present themselves 15 minutes prior to the awards ceremony. Official awards will take place at 6:00pm on July 12th at the J.U.M.P. in downtown Boise at 9th and Front Street.

Article 13. Directions to Time Trial

Glenns Ferry High School is 55 miles East of Boise. From Boise head east on Interstate 84. Take the first exit into Glenns Ferry and turn right on Bannock St. Glenns Ferry High School will be on the right side of Bannock ½ mile from the exit.
